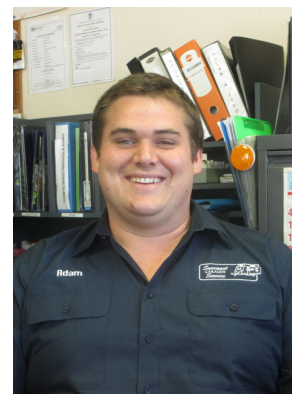
Welcome to our first newsletter for 2013! I apologise that there has not been an issue for a few months, it has been very busy here at Suncoast, but we are back up and running for this year.

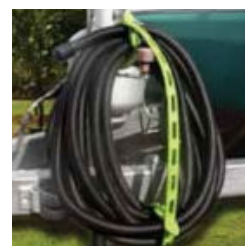

We have found that the smaller mirror is perfect to assist with reverse parking into car parks, especially with the larger 4WD's.



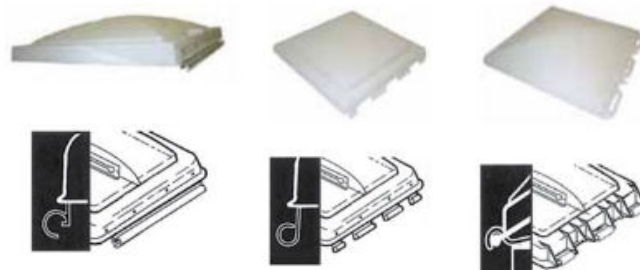

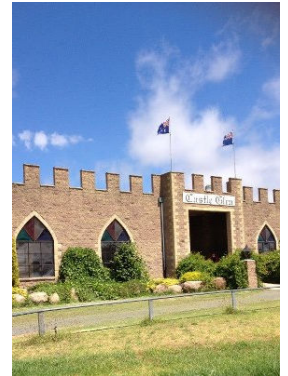

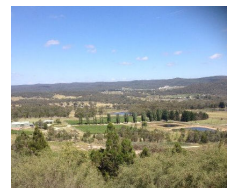
